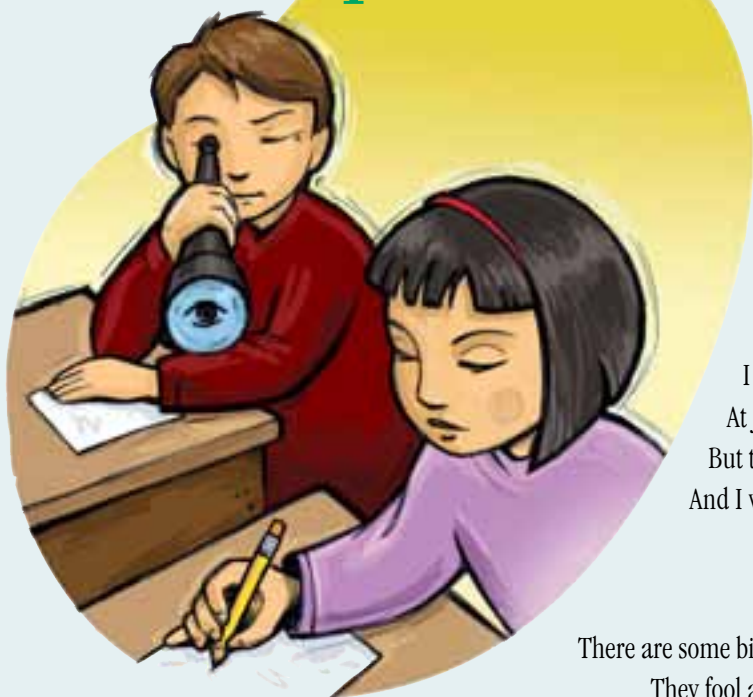




Help from the Holy Ghost
