

Camp Lo Mia Arizona

Camp Lo-Mia has been blessed and dedicated especially for the use of the Young Women.

It is sacred ground to be cared for with love and respect.

Camp Lo Mia is 200 acres of beautiful pine studded recreational property located in Pine, Gila County, Arizona, under the Mogollon Rim, 115 miles northeast of Phoenix. The elevation 5,369 feet above sea level.

The campground is comprised of three separate camp areas of varying capacities, each appropriate for Stake YW Camps, Ward Campouts, Youth Conferences and Family Reunions.

Each camp area has a commercial kitchen, indoor or covered dining halls, cabins with bunk beds and plastic-covered mattresses and modern bathrooms.

In 2015, the Gilbert AZ Stake, blessed the camp with the "Trail of Wonder." It is a short, forest stroll, featuring the Young Women Values and lined with inspirational quotes. The trail leads to a quiet clearing where resides the beautiful statue, "Close to Heaven," by Scott Streadbeck.

MAIN CAMP- 444 BED OCCUPANCY-12 Cabins and 16 Addies

RESERVATION OPTIONS:

1. All of Main Camp may be reserved.
2. The Lodge, only, may be reserved (includes the ability to use the semi-covered Outdoor Stage area, Craft Room and one Ramada)
3. The Lodge, plus the desired number of cabins/addies may be reserved.

THINGS TO KNOW ABOUT MAIN CAMP:

- Lodge with commercial kitchen, dining hall and outdoor stage area. The lodge can sleep about 56 within a staff/leaders' room, nurse's room and a large YCL room. There are several complete restrooms in the lodge. The lodge is not heated.
- Cabins #1 through #12 contain 14 beds. Cabins have wooden doors.
- Addies #1 through #8 contain 10 beds. Addies have half doors with drop down canvas coverings.
- Addies #9 through #16 contain 14 beds. Addies have half doors with drop down canvas coverings.
- Priesthood Cabin (28 beds)
- Wi Fi Access in Lodge and surrounding area for adult leaders only.(See Bro. Taft)
- Craft Room
- 3 Ramadas
- 4 large, complete restroom structures.
- Creekside Chapel Outdoor Assembly Area.
- Flag Pole-(Bring flag.)
- Softball field, volley ball, horse shoe pit, basketball, archery range access. (Bring sports equipment, except horse shoes.)
- Fire Rings. (Must have Camp Manger/Caretaker approval before using.)

- Access to hiking trails.
- Access to Zip Line- (Must have Camp Manger/Caretaker approval before using.)
- Canoes- The camp has six are 6 canoes for use at a body of water off the camp property. (There is a \$50 fee for use of the canoes, life vests and trailer. Must have Camp Manger/Caretaker approval before using)

ORCHARD CAMP-338 BED OCCUPANCY-22 Cabins

RESERVATION OPTIONS:

1. All of Orchard Camp may be reserved.
2. Kitchen with attached, covered Ramada and stage area only, may be reserved.
3. Kitchen with attached, covered Ramada, plus the desired number of cabins may be reserved.

THINGS TO KNOW ABOUT ORCHARD CAMP:

- A commercial kitchen. This structure also contains a Nurse's room, two rooms that each sleep 4 and a restroom. A covered Ramada with tables and benches for dining is attached to this building.
- 22 Addies, each contain 14 beds.
- Staff Room contains 22 beds.
- Craft Room
- 2 large complete restroom structures.
- Orchard Chapel Outdoor Assembly Area
- Flag Pole-(Bring flag)
- Softball field, volley ball, archery range. (Bring sports equipment)
- Fire rings. (Must have Camp Manger/Caretaker approval before using)
- Access to hiking trails.
- Access to Zip Line- (Must have Camp Manger/Caretaker approval before using.)
- Canoes- The camp has 6 canoes for use on a body of water off the camp property. (There is a \$50 fee for use of the canoes, life vests and trailer. Contact the Camp Manger/Caretaker to check on availability.)

WEST CAMP-140 BED OCCUPANCY-6 Cabins and 2 Tent Pads

RESERVATION OPTIONS:

1. Often, all of West Camp is reserved when using this area.
2. Kitchen, with attached Ramada and one cabin.

THINGS TO KNOW ABOUT WEST CAMP:

- A commercial kitchen. A covered Ramada with tables and benches for dining is attached to this building.
- 6 Cabins, each sleeping 20.
- 2 Tent Pads, each large enough for 3-4 tents
- Complete restroom structure.
- Flag Pole- (Bring flag)
- Access to hiking trails.
- Archery range-(Bring equipment)
- Access to Zip Line- (Must have Camp Manger/Caretaker approval before using.)
- Canoes- The camp has 6 canoes for use on a body of water off the camp property. (There is a \$50 fee for use of the canoes, life vests and trailer. Contact the Camp Manger/Caretaker to check on availability.)
