Welcome to Wallsburg Girls Camp

The primary purpose of the Wallsburg Girls Camp is to provide outdoor experiences for young women that will promote their spiritual, social, and cultural development. We accommodate young women camps during the summer weekdays, Monday through Friday mornings. Church groups and families that meet church standards of conduct may also reserve the facility for the remaining open calendar days. There is no Sunday camping.

Exclusive use of the pavilion facilities (kitchen, bathrooms, showers) can only be guaranteed if that entire camp is reserved. If groups share the pavilions, the group leaders will want to meet and coordinate usage and cleaning.

CAMP DESCRIPTION

The Wallsburg Girls Camp is a scenic property located 60 miles Southeast of Salt Lake City and 4 miles Southeast of the town of Wallsburg. The camp is located on 93 acres of beautiful Maple, Oak, Cottonwood, and Willow trees. The camp has several grassy areas for activities and a cool year-round stream winding through the property.

There are two large campgrounds (Oak and Legacy) and a smaller camp (Maple) that include many excellent camping areas with leveled tent sites and limited RV parking. Each camp has a large pavilion with kitchens, refrigerators, propane camp stoves (propane provided), and metal picnic tables. All camps have easy access to culinary water, limited electricity, flushing toilets, showers, fire pits, and an amphitheater (sound systems are available to check out).

The camps are also in close proximity to the Challenge Course, Archery Range, Human Foosball, the large activity field (equipment for various games available for checkout), and a variety of marked scenic hikes with varying degrees of length and difficulty.

Oak and Legacy camps can each facilitate a large group (stake size / about 160-185) and Maple can accommodate one smaller group (ward or family size / about 60). Wallsburg Girls Camp has a total capacity of about 400 occupants at a time and can be scheduled through the LDS Camp Web Site (camping.lds.org).

Reading through the Wallsburg Camp Rules before arriving on site will answer many of your questions and help facilitate a pleasant camping experience.

Wallsburg Girls Camp has two Camp Host Missionary Couples whose purpose is to make your stay as stress-free and enjoyable as possible.

STANDARDS OF CONDUCT
